Bhavan's Vidyashram, is a Senior Secondary school, started in 2001 under the Ramanattukara Kendra of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan. The School is having strength of 806 students in 23 sections from class one to twelve; 45 well qualified teachers and 13 non-teaching staff.

Striving to sustain high standards of a quality school, our academic profile is consistently outstanding. In AISSCE March 2018, all the 11 students passed scoring above 90% marks, the lowest being 60.2%, the highest 96.6% and the average aggregate 81.15%.

In AISSE, out of 61 students 33 secured above 90% and the lowest being 60.8%. The School Average is 87.5. The School has been consistently remaining within the top seven of all Bhavan's Schools all these years from inception. And this year we hold third position among all Bhavan's Schools in India & abroad. The results of AISSE & AISSCE 2017-2018 batches are tabulated below:

The school building with its impressive dome has already become a land-mark in this part of the country visible from the starting point of NH-66 Kozhikode bye-pass. The School is having a grand library of 11,308 books and 521 Educational CDs. Regular Library periods for class I-XII, regular Yoga hours handled by the Yoga-instructor of yogachariya qualification and daily individual counselling sessions & class wise awareness and motivation sessions by the qualified Health & Wellness full-time faculty are underway, as usual.

Under the yearlong CCA System, we completed all the celebrations and important occasions. Our 10th volume of "Amrutham" magazine is released on time. We continued our Charity Programmes of "fistful of rice" "Save to Serve" and "Palliative Care Boxes for birthday."(An amount of 27,213/- was donated by students as Palliative Care Contribution this year.

In Inter Bhavan's , Sate level Competitions, students won all 'A' Grades in their respective items. 32 students took part in 48 items and Lakshmi Sunil Menon of VII std. emerged as winner as she got second prize in Bharatanatyam. Almost all our student performed in a very remarkable way in the event.

Ryan Yohan Renny of II std secured A grade in English Recitation & English Story Telling, Devakjith of I std won A grade in Gita Chanting, Gouri Vijesh of IV std got A grade in Bharatanatyam, Bhagyananda C of III std won A grade in Folk Dance, Keerthana Suresh of IV std got A grade in Hindi Recitation & English Recitation, Aathira R of III std secured A grade in Gita Chanting, Abhinav S Nair of III std got A grade in Malayalam Recitation, Nandana A of VII std won A grade in English Recitation, Lakshmi Sunil Menon of VII std got A grade in

Mohiniyattom, Chinmayi C of X std got A grade in English Recitation, Hindi Recitation & Gita Chanting and Sandra S of XI std secured A grade in Malayalam Recitation.

60 students participated in 72 items for the CBSE District Kalotsav formerly known as Sahodaya Fest. Devadath P of IX std. won 1st prize in tabala & 3rd prize in Mimicry, Lakshmi Sunil Menon of VII, won 2nd prize in Bharatanatyam, 2nd in Folk Dance and 3rd prize in Mohiniyattam, Manjima S M of XI std bagged 2nd prize in Hindi Recitation, Krishnaprasad of XII won 3rd prize in collage, Radhika Raj of VII std won 3rd prize in Light Music, Krishna Priya of X got 3rd prize in Anchoring and Haridev C of IV std won 3rd prize in Water Colouring. And many of them emerged successful with A Grades in different items.

In CBSE State Katotsav, Devadath P (IX) won a commendable 'A' Grade in Tabla.

In All Kerala Bhavan's Scholarship Exam (6/12/17) 175 students participated. 8 students got distinctions, Nived S Sajith of III Std got First rank and Third rank badged by Akash Alexander of III and Anirudh S of X std.

In the Children's Choice All India Drawing & Painting Competition 2017, Adi Parvana of class I, Harikrishnan Yadav S of Class II, Harit L of Class III, Hari N of Class V & Swathi V S of Class VII won Bronze Medal & Certificate.

152 students took part in State Level Maths Talent Search Exam (1/12/17) of Kerala Ganitha Sasthra Parishad where in which 12 out of them got selection in Final round.

Also 434 students sat for the State Level PCM Scholarship Exam (4/11/17) and 145 of them received the scholarship and 5 students from different classes got 5th Rank (Samvritha Vinod of LKG, Parvathi.K of UKG, Ameenafia T P of UKG, Abhinav Vinod of I & Athmika T V of V).

Two teams of our school participated in the Big Buzz Quiz organised by Ideal School, Vallikunnu on 14/11/17. Dresya [(VI B) and Niranjana P P (VII C) were the junior team and Goutham Krishna (IX A) & Aniketh G Menon (IX B) constituted the senior team who eventually won III prize that include the cash prize of Rs.1001/-, certificate & trophy.

In 2017, 62 students appeared for Saral Sanskrit Scholarship Nanthiitha A of class VI, Bala Rajesh of class VI .Samvritha Nandakumar of VII secured distinction & another seven students got distinction and eight out of them got First class.

12 students participated in the District Geetha Chanting Competition conducted by Chinmaya Mission, Calicut in 9 different categories. Among them Diya Manoj of I A secured 11th prize and got selected for State level Competition.

'Smart Kid Competition conducted by Mathrubhoomi, Adithya Shaji of VI std selected as 'Smart Kid.'

A large number of our students enthusiastically participated sports events this year. Our annual sports day is vigorously organised in the month of November. A total of 516 students took part in the event in 16 – 20 items.

Our school Football & Kho-Kho teams made memorable presence in All Kerala Inter Bhavan's at Perumthiruthi Bhavan's School November, 16 students took part in Chess and Dhrupad P of I class won III prize in Roller Skating.

5 students got A1 Grade with Scholarship & gold medal in Sahodaya Scholastic Achievement Test (SSAT).

Sreelakshmi M of class X got Shri Pranlal Devkaran Nanjee award for excellence in harmonious behaviour 2017-18 & received Commendation Certificate & Cash Prize of Rs. 1,100/- from Shikshan Bharati, Mumbai.

Gopika K A of class XII, Krishna Priya A V of class X & Ardra CK of VIII got Sri.C.Subramaniam Award for Excellence in Character – 2017-18 & receiving Certificates, Medals & cash prize of Rs.1500/- from Shikshan Bharati

The School is having 5 sections of Pre-primary classes with 154 students. Apart from the Teacher-in –charge, 5 teachers and 4 ayahs are taking care of the children.
