#### **ANNUAL REPORT (2022-23)**

*Bhavan's Vidyashram*, is a Senior Secondary school, started in 2001 under the Ramanattukara Kendra of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan. In Bhavan's Vidyashram School, we believe that every individual has tremendous potential that can help accomplish wonders The School is having strength of 816 students in 26 sections from class LKG to twelve; 46 well qualified teachers and 16 non-teaching staff.

#### I. A GLIMPSE OF THE ACADEMIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF EXCELLENCE!

Academic excellence always acknowledge the success achieved by the sheer hard work and perseverance of the students, under the expert guidance of their respective mentors.

The school is having a consistently outstanding track record of excellent academic performance as reflected in the CBSE examinations year after year. From the inception of presenting Std. X students for CBSE examination in 2006 and Class XII in 2008, the school stood always at TOP 7 RANKS all these years, among the 80 plus Schools under Vidya Bhavan spread all over India and abroad affiliated to CBSE. In 2014, it was ranked as second and in 2016 it became First, and it stood second in 2017. As per the Educational survey of 'Career 360' in the year 2015 and of 'Learning Point' in 2014, Bhavan's Vidyashram was listed as the No.1 CBSE School in Kerala State.

In AISSCE March 2022, all the 30 students passed with first class. Lakshmi V with 95.8%, Nandagopal V with 95.6% and Akhila Manoj with 94.8% topped the list. 26 out of 30 students secured Distinction marks.

In AISSE, out of 60 students, 28 secured 90% & above 24 secured 80 %-90% & 11 secured 70-80% and class *average is 87.9*. Mahimaraj K P is the topper, scoring 98.8% and Bala Rajesh & Gouri Nanda S bagged II position by scoring 98.4%, each. 57 out of 60 students secured Distinction marks (97% of students).

In 2021, ranked No. 3 among all world Bhavans Schools' and No.1 among Bhavans Schools in Kerala on the basis of CBSE BOARD Exam (AISSCE).

Most modern technological facilities are suitably applied to inculcate up-to-date intellectual abilities, competencies & skill sets in our children, to align with NEP 2020. We have 100% digitally equipped smart-class rooms too, to address the learning & teaching going digital for a digital generation. By our unique inventive design of WEB-CLASSES, our school surpassed the Covid- 19 challenges with a cent percent success!!

## II. Unique Venture of our Kendra – BHAVAN'S WEB-CLASSES (bhavansramclasses.com) by which we successfully overcome Covid challenges

WEB CLASSES (Web streaming of video-lessons on all subjects of all classes: LKG-XII) uniquely endeavoured by Vidyashram & Vidyamandir Teachers, exclusively for our students are being maintained up-to-date right from the month of June 2020 start of Covid 19 providing quality classes to the students in the most student friendly way. The classes are available on the school website and can be accessed anytime from anywhere as per convenience and comfort of the student.

The classes have been taken by their own teachers to make the learning process a friendly and stress free one, as always. All the classes are pre-recorded and hence will be available for anytime, anywhere access to our students 24x7, all along the 365 days of the year. And student's doubt-clearance was also made possible 24x7, unlike any other online classes.

Along with academic subjects, we also equipped students (via Web classes) with life skill subjects like dance, music, yoga, culinary art as part of Art Integrated Learning (AIL), via live online G Meet/ Zoom platforms.

II (b) Post – Covid endeavors to give back whatever is lost for children for two years and the events and programmes for bridging the gaps, compensating & remediating the LEARNING GAPS and BASE-BUILDING tasks:

As per surveys world-over, the students suffered 40 to 60% Learning Loss during Covid schooling. Their socio-emotional well-being was also hugely affected. Our School-system (Management, teachers & other staff) have been fully ready & very well foreseen this post-covid scenario, and we had done our home-work 100% to rebuild all what is lost to the students during covid-closures.

- (1) Bridge-sessions for remediation of learning gaps, have been specially conducted during afternoons in the month of November 2021 to March 2022 (for 5 months), when the Govt. permitted to re-open the schools in a phased-manner after the Covid-closures. These months have been exclusively dedicated for taking up varied session activities, measures for bridging the Learning-loss & gaps, with a clear planning: for egs:-
- (2) All teachers are asked to dedicate at least the first 10 minutes of their each period for base-building, bridging the losses and remediation measures, during the current year.
- (3) Respected Director proposed "the Learning Capsules" (important areas of each subject in a capsule form to be made available online to the students of all classes by all the Subject-Teachers). It was effectively carried-out by each teacher for each student of all classes during the summer-holiday months of April-May 2022.
- (4) Saturday Programmes (in 2022) have been specially designed to address to build back the covid-time educational losses to all our school-children, especially the lower-class-students!

## XII. Bhavan's Vidyamandir [Pre-Primary School]

Bhavan's Vidyamandir is the Pre-primary School under the Kendra. It is functioning in a uniquely designed building constructed in the campus adjoining to Bhavan's Vidyashram.
